

Green Homes Grant: make energy improvements to your home

SEHBAC are a Trustmark Registered Company, Licence No. 1899448 and Fensa Registered 11448.

Vouchers will cover two-thirds of the cost of eligible improvements, up to a maximum government contribution of £5,000.

If someone in a household, receives certain benefits they may be eligible for a voucher covering 100% of the cost of the improvements. The maximum value of the voucher is £10,000.

Vouchers must be redeemed and improvements completed by 31 March 2021.

The voucher must be used to install at least 1 primary measure.

At least 1 primary measure must be installed for the voucher to be used to help cover the cost of Windows & Doors which is classed as a secondary measure. The amount towards the cost of secondary measures cannot exceed the amount given for the primary measures.

Vouchers for secondary measures can only be redeemed once a primary measure has been installed and vouchers redeemed for that measure.

Customers need 3 quotes and then submit them to the “governing body” who will then select which Company they want to issue vouchers against

Once your voucher has been issued, the installer can begin the work.

Your installer may ask you for a deposit. This should not be larger than the amount they would normally charge. It cannot be larger than your expected contribution to the cost of measures under the quote they have provided you.

If you're applying under the low-income scheme, your installer cannot ask you for a deposit unless the cost of your measures is more than £10,000. Redeeming the voucher

To redeem your voucher you'll need to confirm that:

- the installation was completed satisfactorily before the voucher expiry date
- you have received the necessary documents from the installer
- you have paid your share of the costs to the installer (if applicable)
- you meet the relevant eligibility requirements

You will need to provide a dated copy of the invoice issued by the installer

When you redeem your voucher the grant will be paid on your behalf directly to the installer.
